### BLESSED TO SERVE

- 5 home projects for church members
- 2 projects pending

### CARLISLE CARES

#### Women & Children's Shelter

- Hosted 5 months
- Averaged 14-18 guests/night
- 14-20 different hosts volunteered each month.

#### Adult Shelter

- Hosted January and April
- 1,147 mats used in Jan., 997 in April
- Averaged 39 guests/night
- 32 different hosts volunteered

### FRUITBELT FARMWORKERS

- 60 blankets, 50 sweatshirts, 40 Spanish Bibles donated
- Meal together with 50 people

### LITTLE LIGHTS READERS

- 11 reading in 7 classrooms
- 102 kids at Little Lights

### MY BROTHER'S TABLE (Salvation Army)

- Served 80-120 meals/month
- 6-8 servers/month

### PET PROJECT (Project SHARE)

- 11 PETs completed; 102 in progress

### SAFE HARBOUR TUTORING

- 9 kids tutored each week
- 7 volunteer tutors
- 5 summer outings with 10-13 kids

### SIERRA LEONE DRESSES

- 57 dresses sent to Sierra Leone for little girls

### UPWARD SPORTS PROGRAM

- 228 players/cheerleaders in basketball season
- 139 players/cheerleaders in football season

### HAITI TEAM

- 120 Haitians served by CUMC with worship, working and activities
- 3 tons of sand sifted for cement walls
- 20 suitcases of donated clothes, school supplies, and health kits
- \$7000 donated to Grace Children's Hospital, lunch program, building projects & staff rebuilding their homes
- 10 members went to Yvon Haiti

### VOLUNTEERS IN MISSION

- 25 volunteers, 7 participated on 2+ trips
- worked on 4 homes in NYC, 2 homes in PA, and helped with Harrisburg Habitat
- 328 hrs serving on 3 trips and 1 day project

### OTHER DONATIONS

- \$8641 Alternative Gifts
- \$5758 Project SHARE for beef stew
- 108 turkey dinner bags
- \$1560 Thanksgiving dinners
- 144 beef stew; 106 other items
